

Directions to the RCRC Boathouse/Port of Sacramento

From West (SF, etc):

I-80 East to Capitol City Freeway/Business 80 to West Sacramento

EXIT Harbor Blvd.

LEFT onto Harbor heading south.

RIGHT at second light, Industrial Blvd.

LEFT through opening in fence, just west of guarded main Port entrance. The gate is posted: "Riverside Aggregate and Laborers Training Center"

FOLLOW winding road. **FOLLOW** directions of parking attendants.

From East (Sacramento, South Lake Tahoe, etc):

Capitol City Freeway/Business 80 to West Sacramento

EXIT Harbor Blvd.

RIGHT onto Harbor heading south.

RIGHT at third light, Industrial Blvd.

LEFT through opening in fence, just west of guarded main Port entrance. The gate is posted: "Riverside Aggregate and Laborers Training Center"

FOLLOW winding road. **FOLLOW** directions of parking attendants.

From North (Redding, Humboldt, etc):

I-5 South to I-80 West

I-80 West to Capital City Freeway/Business 80 to Sacramento

First **EXIT** Harbor Blvd.

Follow "From West" directions above.

From South (Stockton, etc):

I-5 North to Capitol City Freeway/Business 80 to San Francisco (and West Sacramento)

Follow "From East" directions above.

Parking Information for the River City Junior Fall Regatta:

Parking for this regatta will be limited. Please encourage your teams to carpool and/or bus. If needed, we will restrict parking near the boathouse to cars with rowers/coaches. We highly encourage spectators to park at one of the following 2 locations:

(1) Street parking is available on Halyard Blvd and Beacon Blvd outside of the Port of Sacramento. Follow the above directions, but after turning right onto Industrial Blvd, take the next right onto Halyard Blvd and park. Carefully walk across Industrial Blvd and follow the winding road to the boathouse. This is probably about 1 mile from the launching area.

(2) Better views of the racing can be seen from the levee. We suggest that spectators view the regatta along the levee (spans the entire race course). There will be no officials on the bridge. Spectators are not allowed to view the races from the bridge. To get to the levee, follow the above directions, but instead of turning right onto Industrial Blvd, turn **LEFT** onto Industrial Blvd. Follow Industrial over the bridge. Directly after the bridge, there is parking on the right. You can also access the dirt road that runs along the levee on the south side of the race course from this location.
